



Free Library Books for your Kindle!?

Follow these instructions to learn how easy it is to stop paying for every title you want.

To access Kindle books available through the Whitman Public Library, you will need:

- A valid library card
- Access to the Internet
- A computer OR Wi-Fi enabled on your Kindle

Step 1: Visit the Whitman Library Website www.whitmanpubliclibrary.org;

On the left side of the screen, follow the link to “Download audio books and eBooks **OverDrive.**” This will take you to the OCLN Digital Media Collection.

Step 2: Find a title you'd like to read.

- You can use the Quick Search box at the top of the screen to search by Author, Title or ISBN;
- Browse—look through new eBooks, or other categories like recently returned eBooks in the boxes further down the main screen



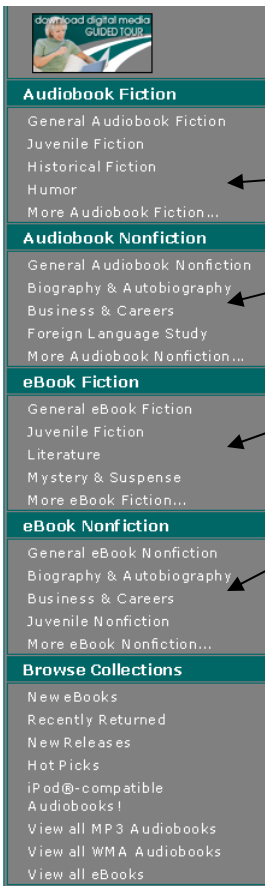

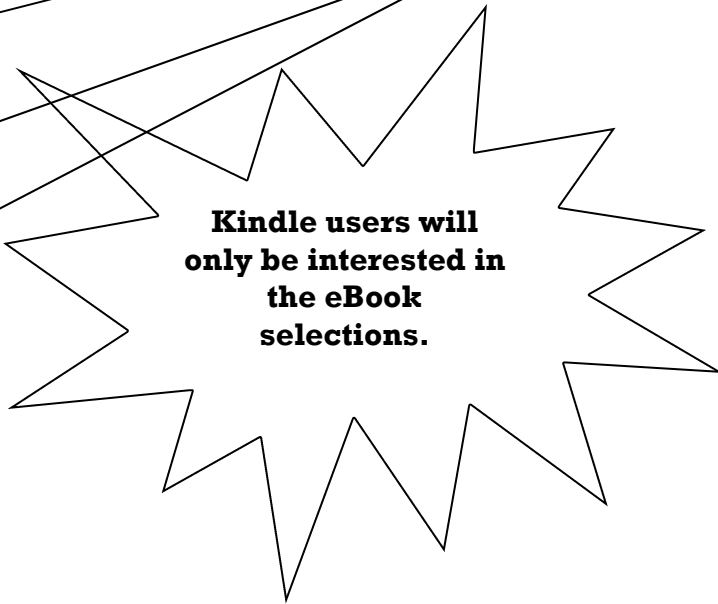

Note that these are separated by Audiobooks and eBooks.



Step 3: Once you have located a title you would like to borrow, click on it.



As you can see above, this title is available in two formats: Kindle and Adobe EPUB. You will want the Kindle version. You can also tell that this title **is not immediately available** because the only option is to place a hold. If you would like to be put on the waiting list, follow this link to enter your library card number. Once it is available you will receive an email notifying you—you will then have **3 days** to retrieve it before it goes on to the next person waiting.

Keep reading to find out how to retrieve an available title...





- Public library books require an active Wi-Fi connection for wireless delivery to a Kindle device. Library books will not be delivered via your Kindle's 3G connection.
- Kindle automatically backs up all of your notes and highlights. If you choose to purchase the book at a later date from the Kindle Store or check it out again, all your notes and highlights will be preserved.

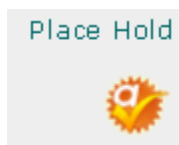
Click on Get Library Book to download the book onto your device (Kindle apps that are registered to you will also show in the drop down menu, if you choose to have the title sent to your iPad or other device).

Step 7: If your device supports wireless transfers, the final step in retrieving it is connecting to a Wi-Fi source. If you're unable to get wireless, then you can download the title to your computer, plug in your Kindle, and transfer the title manually. For information on how to transfer manually, please see the Overwhelmed by Overdrive tutorial, available online at www.whitmanpubliclibrary.org, or at the Library.

Step 8: Enjoy your title for 2 weeks! If you finish early and want to make it available to others, you can manage your Kindle on the Amazon website, and choose the action "Return this Book" beside the library book. Otherwise, at the end of your loan period, the title will automatically disappear from your device. Titles cannot be renewed, but you can check them out again if they are available when the checkout period ends.

Final Hints:

- Adding to your wish list will not place you on hold. This is a list you can create for personal use.
- The gold icon indicates it is an Overdrive Advantage title. This is a local holds system for digital media, reserving certain titles for patrons from a specific town. If you see this icon, you can sign in to check to see if it is available for Whitman patrons.
